

Rockville County Park



Just a few miles south of St. Joe is a treasure that abounds in natural wonders. Several interesting hiking trails are at your boot tips. You can opt for a trail that meanders past a small stream and around numerous [erratics](#) and while climbing through the hard-wood forest to an observation platform from which you can see for miles and observe the once much wider Sauk River drainage. another trail you'll overlook a pristine tamarack seepage bog and a little further along the massive bald eagle nest. The trails are unimproved, meaning not paved, and you'll probably want to bring some insect repellent. Some of the trails are open to horse traffic so you'll want to watch your step. There are very well maintained pit toilets near the parking lot.
